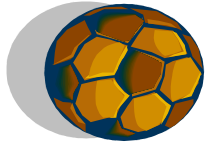
## Canceling or Changing Lunch Orders:

I trust that you are all having a wonderful and meaningful Advent. It is during this time of the year that I always feel especially privileged to be a part of Notre Dame School where we can share the blessings of the season together.

It has been quite a while since I have communicated with you in regards to my health and teaching at Notre Dame. First of all, I'd like to thank everyone for the incredible support I've received through prayers, cards, meals and just plain kind words. I'd also like to let you know that all is going well for me in the context of the "job" I have to do. Generally, my body is tolerating the chemotherapy well, and my long term outlook is still very positive. Also, I'm pleased to report that I've crossed over the halfway point of my treatments. I've now completed eight of the twelve prescribed cycles!

As for my teaching schedule, I have decided to take a break until the end of my chemotherapy which should be around February 1. I do miss all the children very much but realize that at this time I need to focus my greatest energies on getting well. Please know that Mrs. Ward and I will remain in close contact as she continues to cover my teaching responsibilities. I feel unbelievably fortunate that she is available and willing to so "seamlessly" take on my duties.

You and Notre Dame School are in my daily thoughts and prayers. Please know that I'm very much looking forward to being back to work with all the children - VERY SOON.
